At the author's request, the following corrections are suggested for the article entitled "Cerebrospinal Fluid Scanning with ^{111}In " (*J Nucl Med* 12: 668-672, 1971):

Page 669, paragraph 6: "When the activity of the ^{111}In approached 10 mCi/ml, only 0.15 mg of trans-

ferrin and 3.5 mg of total protein (0.05 ml serum) was required . . ." In addition, on page 669, paragraph 9: "The patient was studied in the usual manner with a lumbar intrathecal injection of 0.50 mCi of the ^{111}In -transferrin complex in less than 0.2 cc."
