from good (in most cases) to fair. The illustrations are adequate to illustrate the point being made in all cases except one (Fig. 14.9b), which appears to represent a printing error. The book is nicely printed and bound. Typographical errors are infrequent. One section of text refers to "radionuclide arthroscopy" instead of the intended "radionuclide arthrography".

For whom is the book intended? The publisher states that the book "will be of value to nuclear medicine specialists, and others in fields such as endocrinology, rheumatology, orthopaedics and oncology will find much of relevance." That is probably a fair assessment, but since the other specialists will need to know a good deal about nuclear medicine to gain much from the book, the most appropriate readers are nuclear medicine physicians and residents, who will indeed find much of value.

The book has many strengths, and the few weaknesses noted above are minor in comparison. It belongs in any nuclear medicine physician's library, based on its merits, but its price is exceptionally high considering its length and the good but not spectacular quality of the illustrations. It should be available to all nuclear medicine residents, most likely in the departmental or institutional library. Nuclear medicine physicians who are not concerned about the price should buy it.
