**REPLY:** We appreciate the comments from Dr. Langsteger and colleagues. As they pointed out, we did not cite their case report (1) because the article did not show up in our computerized literature search on Medline. We deeply regret this unintentional omission, because, as they suggested, their detailed consideration on aberrant iodine uptake could surely have enriched our case report. As for another, more recent article by Haubold-Reuter et al. (2), we could not refer to it because the issue of JNM containing that paper reached our department after the submission of our manuscript. In addition, the letter to the editor referencing the Haubold-Reuter case report (3) had not yet been printed at the time of our submission.

Regarding their second point, we did not state only two incidences of iodine-trapping nonthyroidal tumors. We were well aware of the reports of false-positive cases (meningioma, thymoma, Zenker's diverticulum, etc.) in radioiodine scans. For the brevity of our manuscript, we quoted the two as examples.

We would like to say, as others have already said (1,2), that when interpreting an iodine whole-body scan, one should keep in mind the rare but important possibility of extrathyroidal tumors.
