REPLY: Of course, you are correct! Not only should I have known that Janus was a Roman god, I do know it. His name alone clearly identifies him as of Latin origin rather than Greek. I guess when one relaxes a bit, you do not notice your own slips of the tongue or pen. There is some comfort in knowing that at least one reader read *Scatter* in January and was

informed enough to know the differences between the Greek and Roman pantheon.
