

Supplemental Video 1: Representative example of video showing the relative sparing of the supraclavicular region with respect to maintaining its temperature over time in response to a cold stimulus. Each frame is comprised of a rolling average of three consecutive images. Using the first frame as a reference, each consecutive frame is transformed (via translation, rotation, and scale) on to the first and compared to it. Areas that are the same temperature as the reference image are white; areas that are increasingly warmer than the original are red through orange to yellow; and areas that are increasingly cooler than the original are blue through to black.
